



Third Party Consent to Release Personal Information Marihuana for Medical Purposes Regulation (MMPR)

A Canadian police force, the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP), or private fingerprinting agencies accredited by the RCMP can submit your fingerprints electronically to the RCMP on your behalf. The fees for electronic fingerprint submission vary and must be paid by the applicant at the time the service is performed.

Important information and instructions for completion of *Third Party Consent to Release Personal Information* form under the *Marihuana for Medical Purposes Regulations (MMPR)*

Note: As part of the *Application to become a Licensed Producer under the Marihuana for Medical Purposes Regulations*, a fingerprint check <u>must</u> be conducted for all parties identified in the application. This includes applicants that apply as individual, the proposed Senior Person in Charge, and the proposed Responsible Person(s) in charge. In the case of a corporation, each Director and Officer of the corporation must also submit fingerprints and a duly completed *Third Party Consent to Release Personal Information* form.

A Canadian police force, the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) or private fingerprinting agencies accredited by the RCMP can submit your fingerprints electronically to the RCMP on your behalf. The fees for electronic fingerprint submission vary and must be paid by the applicant at the time the service is performed.

General:

- 1. This form is to be brought with the applicant to the local Police Station or private fingerprinting agency accredited by the RCMP where their fingerprints will be taken.
- 2. This form must be completed in front of the person taking the fingerprints.
- 3. It is very important that a single digit ink print be placed in the box on the form and the finger used identified by circling the appropriate one next to the box. Failure to do so will result in delays.
- 4. This form must be signed and dated by the applicant.
- 5. This form <u>must</u> be submitted to the RCMP at the same time as fingerprints taken on *Form C-216C at your local Police Station or RCMP private accredited fingerprinting agency, whether electronically or by mail (in case of roll and ink prints).
- 6. This form must be submitted as part of your Security Clearance Application Form package.

*Form C-216C is the standard RCMP form used for fingerprinting

- This form is not available online
