Summary

The Building Maintenance Worker, under the direction of the Facilities Manager, is responsible for performing general maintenance and repair. The incumbent completes general carpentry and electrical repair and maintenance work as required. The Building Maintenance Worker also performs basic repairs and maintenance on the mechanical operating systems found within the facility.

Job Duties

- Perform simple machinist duties and responsibilities
- Perform regular preventive maintenance on machines and equipment
- Perform a variety of plumbing maintenance tasks as required
- Conduct general carpentry functions
- Use a variety of hand and power tools, electric meters and material handling equipment while performing duties
- Comply with safety regulations and maintain clean and orderly work areas
- Participate in various aspects of building maintenance requirements, including updates and new constructions
- Set priorities for preventive maintenance work orders, maintenance requisitions and scheduled work
- Maintain adequate supplies for the maintenance department
- Complete all necessary reports and records related to the department as required
- Perform regular workplace inspections to determine areas that need maintenance or repair
- Ensure that any required maintenance and repairs are completed in a timely manner
- Prepare, paint and decorate interior and exterior surfaces as required
- Operate grounds-keeping power equipment and maintain external property

- Perform minor construction work, e.g., repairingdamaged walls, carpentry work, pouring concrete, etc.
- Conduct minor repairs to electrical locks and control panels to maintain building security
- Troubleshoot, install, and repair plumbing fixtures, piping, and related equipment
- Perform necessary work to open clogged sewer lines
- Initiate safety concerns and makes judgment on the best methods of completing tasks
- Perform basic maintenance and repairs on the various mechanical operating systems found at DelShen Therapeutics, including furnace systems, air conditioning systems, etc.
- Inspect the premises for burnt out light bulbs ensure these are replaced immediately
- Change furnace and air conditioning filters as needed
- Repair doors, door locks and install/replace window blinds, etc....
- Complete daily, weekly and monthly checklists on building equipment maintenance procedures
- Maintain records of scheduled maintenance procedures
- Any other duties as required
